### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The second edition of the Sustainable Action Conference (SAC 2024), theme "Transforming Pledges into Action: Realizing a Sustainable Future" stood as a testament to transform sustainability commitments into tangible actions. Held on 21st November 2024 at the Sunway Resort Hotel, Malaysia, SAC 2024 was co-organized by Control Union Malaysia and the Malaysian Dutch Business Council (MDBC), with esteemed support from the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands of Malaysia and the Malaysia Green Technology and Climate Change Corporation (MGTC).

### MISA PTICHING SESSION

The MISA Pitching Sessions 2024 showcased innovative and impactful sustainability initiatives across three key award categories: Environmental Excellence, Social Impact, and Governance Leadership.

With themes focusing on the **Best Suitable Built Environment**, **Best Workforce Sustainable Engagement**, and **Best Sustainability Communication**, the sessions recognized outstanding achievements in environmental conservation, social equity, and transparent governance practices.

Each session featured live pitches assessed by a panel of expert judges, and an interactive audience voting system added a participatory element to the selection process. The sessions served as a dynamic platform to spotlight organizations driving meaningful change and setting benchmarks in ESG excellence.









### **FUNDING PROJECT**

The SAC 2024 was not just about dialogue – it was about action! Ten proposals from Ten Malaysia NGOs dedicated to impactful sustainability projects were submitted for consideration. A panel of judges carefully reviewed the proposals based on criteria such as innovation, scalability, and potential impact. After a thorough evaluation, there finalists were selected to pitch their projects during the MISA Awards and Dinner Ceremony.

The first pitcher, **The Lost Food Project**, showcased its <u>Green Plates Program</u>, which redistributes surplus food to underprivileged families. This initiative reduces food waste while addressing food insecurity for over 770 households in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. By rescuing perfectly edible food that would otherwise be discarded, the program not only provides nutrition to those in need but also contributes to a more sustainable and environmentally responsible community.

The second pitcher, **Dignity for Children Foundation** presented their **Empowerment of Orang Asli Youth Project**, which addresses the educational challenges faced by Orang Asli communities. This project introduces a culturally inclusive, skills-based learning model for 25 youth, focusing on employability in early childhood education, hairdressing, and food and beverage services. By providing relevant skills and education, the project empowers these young individuals to overcome barriers to employment and thrive in the modern economy.

The last pitcher, **WWF-Malaysia** presented the **LEAP-CCA Model for Climate Change Adaptation**, a community-based initiative to strengthen coastal resilience in Sabah's Semporna Priority Conservation Area. This project seeks to integrate climate change adaptation measures into state policies, while also enhancing marine conservation efforts. By engaging local communities, WWF-Malaysia aims to build resilience against climate change, protecting both the environment and the livelihoods of those living in these coastal areas.

Through a vote by the attendees, **Dignity for Children Foundation was awarded MYR50,000.00** to support their Empowerment of Orang Asli Youth Project. This generous contribution would not have been possible without the support of SAC 2024's generous sponsors: **Control Union Malaysia**, **CarbonSpace**, **Saxon Renewables**, **SaraCarbon**, **EPIC Berhad**, and **Corsair**. ### SUSTAINABILITY PRACTICES

The SAC 2024 (2.0) set a new benchmark for future events by hosting a **carbon-neutral and plastic-free event**, showcasing Control Union's dedication to sustainability. This impactful initiative would not have been possible without the sponsorship from Saxon Renewables – specialise in transforming ambitious sustainability into tangible, measurable outcomes.

#### **CARBON-NEUTRAL EVENT**

SAC 2024 (2.0) was proudly conducted as a carbon-neutral event, with the support of Saxon Renewables through the Kuamut Rainforest Conservation Project. All Scope 1, 2, and 3 emissions associated with the event were calculated and offset — including emissions from electricity consumption, waste generation, materials used, and attendee travel and accommodations.

In line with our commitment to sustainability, the conference menu was carefully curated to minimize environmental impact, ensuring that sustainability was considered in every aspect of the event experience.

The conference has successfully offset 12 tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent (tCO2e) through the Kuamut Rainforest Conservation Project, Malaysia's first nature-based carbon initiative registered under VERRA powered by Saxon Renewables. This project supports biodiversity preservation, combats climate change, and promotes sustainable development, aligning with the conference's ethos.





### RETIREMENT OF ONE CARBON CREDIT AS TOKEN OF APPRECIATION FOR SPEAKERS

As a token of appreciation for our speakers' invaluable contributions to the Sustainable Action Conference (SAC) 2024, one carbon credit was retired on behalf of each speaker. The carbon credit was sourced from the Kuamut Rainforest Conservation Project, Malaysia's first and only nature-based carbon initiative registered under VERRA.

This retirement was proudly sponsored by Saxon Renewables, In recognition of the role our speakers played in advancing meaningful sustainability dialogue.

#### **PLASTIC-FREE**

The elimination of plastic usage was a significant step in advancing sustainability efforts. By opting out of the shell scheme booths for the exhibition, demonstrated that exhibitors can still showcase their products and services in a sustainable manner. In collaboration with the hotel, plastic bottles were replaced with eco-friendly alternatives and SAC 2024 goodie bags contained only reusable and eco-friendly items, ensuring no disposable waste was generated.



## Sustainability reporting kicks off on Jan 1, starting with PLCs having market cap of RM2 billion or more



KUALA LUMPUR: Bursa Malaysia will initiate its phased implementation of the National Sustainability Reporting Framework (NSRF) starting Jan 1, 2025, with public-listed companies boasting a market capitalisation of RM2 billion or more required to begin sustainability disclosures.

Bursa Malaysia chief regulatory officer Julian Mahmud Hashim said the rollout is a structured approach to align Malaysia with international standards, including the International Financial Reporting Standards Sustainability Disclosure Standards.

The initiative aims to drive transparency, enhance investor confidence, and strengthen Malaysia's position in the global capital market.

"This framework is not only a key step toward corporate accountability but also reinforces nation's commitment to net-zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050," Julian stated at the Sustainable Action Conference 2024 (SAC2024) organised by Control Union today.

He said the phased rollout offers clear pathway as the implementation is divided into three

"Large PLCs, Group 1, will begin disclosures for financial years starting January 1, 2025. Mid-sized PLCs, Group 2, will follow suit in 2026, while Group 3. Ace Market PLCs and large non-listed companies, will join by 2027. This progressive timeline ensures businesses can integrate comprehensive sustainability strategies without overwhelming their operations."


Wolff-Bye said sustainability must evolve from theory to tangible action.
